<b>50</b>				If CDs is last period the Ship's Company forms up in the normal parade state with the Coxswain already in charge.
<b>51</b>		Guard PO	The Guard PO moves forward three paces from the dais and salutes.	<p>The Guard PO addresses the dignitary in the following manner: "I am (rank and name). The guard of the (Name of RCSCC), is ready for your inspection Sir/Ma'am"</p> <p>The Guard PO accompanies the dignitary during the inspection. When the inspection is finished the Guard PO returns to the dais with the dignitary. When the dignitary is on the dais, the Guard PO asks :</p> <p>“permission to carry on,”</p> <p>salutes and returns to his/her position. The review group will be composed of the dignitary and the Guard PO only. No other division will be inspected at this time.</p>
<b>52</b>		CPO1	The CPO1 moves three paces forward from the dais, and salutes.	<p>The CPO1 addresses the dignitary in the following manner:</p> <p>"I am (rank and name). The Ship's company of the (Name of RCSCC), is ready for your inspection Sir/Ma'am"</p>

				<p>The CPO1 accompanies the dignitary during the inspection. They may be accompanied by persons designated by the Commanding officer. When the inspection is completed, the CPO1 returns to the dais with the dignitary. It is not necessary for the dignitary to inspect all divisions. Many persons may divide this function.</p>
53		DPO	<p>Once the RO has cleared off the dais will turn right and march up to the right marker and await the arrival of the reviewing party.</p> <p>When the RO has arrived the DPO will exchange salutes and report in the following manner:</p> <p>“I am rank and name, Victory is ready for your inspection”</p> <p>The DPO then take place next to the RO. Once the inspection is complete the DPO remains next to the rear right marker and exchanges salutes with the RO and request:</p> <p>“Permission to carry on”</p> <p>Once the RO is clear the DPO marches up to their original position and stands the division at easy.</p>

<b>95</b>	(Name of RCSCC) WILL ADVANCE IN REVIEW ORDER, (7 PACES) BY THE CENTER, QUICK – MARCH	CPO1		The Ship's company marches forward fifteen paces. If there is not enough space they may take seven paces forward. The words "seven paces" are used when this distance is required. The words "fifteen paces" are not used when they advance this distance.
<b>96</b>	(Name of RCSCC), GENERAL/ROYAL SALUTE, PRESENT-ARMS	CPO1	All DPOs salute at the last movement of the guard.	There is a general salute when the dignitary holds the rank of Lieutenant Commander or higher. If the dignitary is a member of the Royal Family, the Royal salute is imperative.
<b>97</b>	GUARD SLOPE – ARMS	CPO1		All DPOs come to attention at the last movement of the guard.
<b>98</b>	MARCH OFF GUARD AND BAND	CPO1		Command is given once the dignitary has left the dais.
<b>99</b>	GUARD RIGHT – TURN	Guard PO		
<b>100</b>	GUARD AND BAND QUICK – MARCH	Guard PO		The guard withdraws to the right flank. The band may do the same or execute a counter march and withdraw to the rear.
<b>101</b>	(Name of RCSCC) STAND AT – EASE	CPO1		
<b>102</b>	CHIEF	CPO1		The CPO2 presents himself and receives his instructions. The CPO1 returns afterwards and leaves the parade square.
<b>103</b>	(Name of RCSCC) ATTEN-TION	CPO2		Given once the CPO1 has left the parade square.
<b>104</b>		CPO2		The CPO2 carries out the instructions received from the CPO1 and dismisses the Ship's company.
