Job Description

1. The Regulating Petty Officer is the chief of the Operations Department and is a minimum rank of Chief Petty Officer Second Class. The RPO will be responsible for ensuring the operations department runs according to Corps Standing Orders and Operations SOPs.

Primary Duties

General

- 1. Co-ordinating with the Coxswain and other CHODs in matters concerning the Operations Department.
- 2. Preparing Sections of the Operations Routine Orders by gathering required information.
- 3. Ensuring all Operations Chiefs and Petty Officers are meeting the requirements of their terms of reference.
- 4. Ensuring the Ops Chiefs and Petty Officers are meeting the required uniform standard as set out in CATO 35-01 and the Corps Standing Orders.
- 5. Keeping the Ops O advised.
- 6. Promoting Esprit Du Corps within the Operations Department.
- 7. Assisting the Ops Chiefs and Petty Officers with conducting their duties as needed.
- 8. Recommending any changes to Ops SOPs to the Ops O.

Divisions and Watches

- 1. Ensuring the Divisions meet the standard of drill, drill dress & deportment by developing the DPOs leadership skills and knowledge of regulations.
- 2. Initiating the phone calls to the POOWs and the forwarding a phone call report to the Ops O.
- 3. Ensuring the divisional and watch nominal rolls are kept up to date
- 4. To compile a list of cadets who have been AWOL twice or more times in the following month at the beginning of each month and submitting the names to the Ops O

Duty Watch

- 1. Producing weekly duty schedules
- 2. Ensuring all ceremonies meet the standard set out in the Manuel of Ceremony for HMC Ships, Submarines and Naval Reserve Divisions.
- 3. To ensure that distinguished visitors are received with appropriate honours.

Parade

1. Ensuring that parade routines & ceremonial events meet the standards set out in the CFP 201, the Sea Cadet Manuel of Drill and Ceremony and the CFP 200.
